Composing my own pieces makes me totally liberated, and that helps me tremendously as a performer."

We look forward to hearing one of his works, the Three Istrian Dances for Violin and Piano, at this year's festival, and hope that composing takes up as much of his time as possible in the coming two months. It's not that we want Dejan to forget about his other passion – we just want him safe and sound for this year's <u>Festival</u> <u>Maribor</u>.
